Weekend 1: August 12-14, 2011

Workshop 1: •Watercolor: A Fresh Start Weekend, with Helen Klebesadel
Schedule: Friday afternoon (1-4), all day Saturday (10-4), and Sunday (10-4)
Cost: \$225.

Bring your own sack lunches and drinks and we will picnic.

This two and a half day weekend watercolor workshop is designed for absolute beginners as well as for those who have had some experience painting with watercolor but need a refresher to start again. Plan on enjoying this opportunity to learn or re-learn watercolor from an artist passionate about the medium. Workshop participants will explore basic traditional approaches to watercolor painting as well as fresh and experimental watercolor techniques. The goal is to send participants home with the skills and tools to keep on painting.

Workshop 2: • Give Meaning and Memory through Found Object Sculpture, with Liese Pfeifer
Schedule: Friday afternoon (4-8), all day Saturday (10-4), and Sunday (10-4)
Total Workshop Cost: \$200.00, or register for each day separately.

This course is made of three parts (separate register possible) for beginner creative soul or experienced artist.

- **Workshop 2b: How Artists See**, Friday: 4-8 pm, \$60.00
Explore visual clues in nature and our lives and how we give them meaning. Brush up on design basics that inform your ability to create impelling compositions. Materials provided or bring your favorite sketchbook.
- **Workshop 2c: Found Object Dilemma**, Saturday only: 10am-4pm, \$90.00
How to bring chaos into harmony; Use a variety of recycled materials to create something new. Technical workshop about connecting objects using adhesives, binding, joining and fastening. Materials provided or bring some with you. Bring sack lunch.
- **Workshop 2d: Objects as purveyors of meaning**, Sunday only: 10am-4pm, \$90.00
Create a mixed media sculpture using a personal collectable as focal point. Bring personal collectible and sketchbook. Supporting materials provided. Bring sack lunch.

Weekend 2: August 19-21, 2011

Workshop 3: Finding Your Creative Voice in Mixed Media Weekend, with Helen Klebesadel

August 19-21, 2011

Schedule: Friday afternoon (1-4), all day Saturday (10-4), and Sunday (10-4), \$225.

Spend a weekend using mixed media collage to take the next steps toward overcoming the internal censors that stop you from moving forward in your art. Begin to develop a personal iconography in your art and find a path toward bringing what you care about into your art and learning how to use your own life as a resource. The workshop is designed to accommodate experienced and beginning artists who would like to participate in guided projects that will open them up to new directions.

Additional Options • Private lesson/coaching

From August 14th to August 19th Helen will be available in the Spring Green area to schedule private lessons or coaching/supportive critique session. Each session will be approximately 1 1/2 hour long and will cost \$50.

Instructor: Helen R. Klebesadel grew up in Wyoming Valley and Spring Green, Wisconsin and now maintains a studio in Madison. She taught art and gender studies at Lawrence University from 1990 to 2000 and is currently director of the UW System Women's Studies Consortium. Watercolor painting is her specialty. Helen exhibits her work nationally and internationally, and has been invited to teach watercolor workshops from Texas to Alaska.
